Definition of At-Risk Populations (ARP) People over 60 – however, not everyone is the same, which is why folks should talk to their doctor,

1. anyone with an immune-compromising condition,
2. anyone with poorly controlled diabetes,
3. anyone with pulmonary disease,
4. anyone who has had a transplant.
