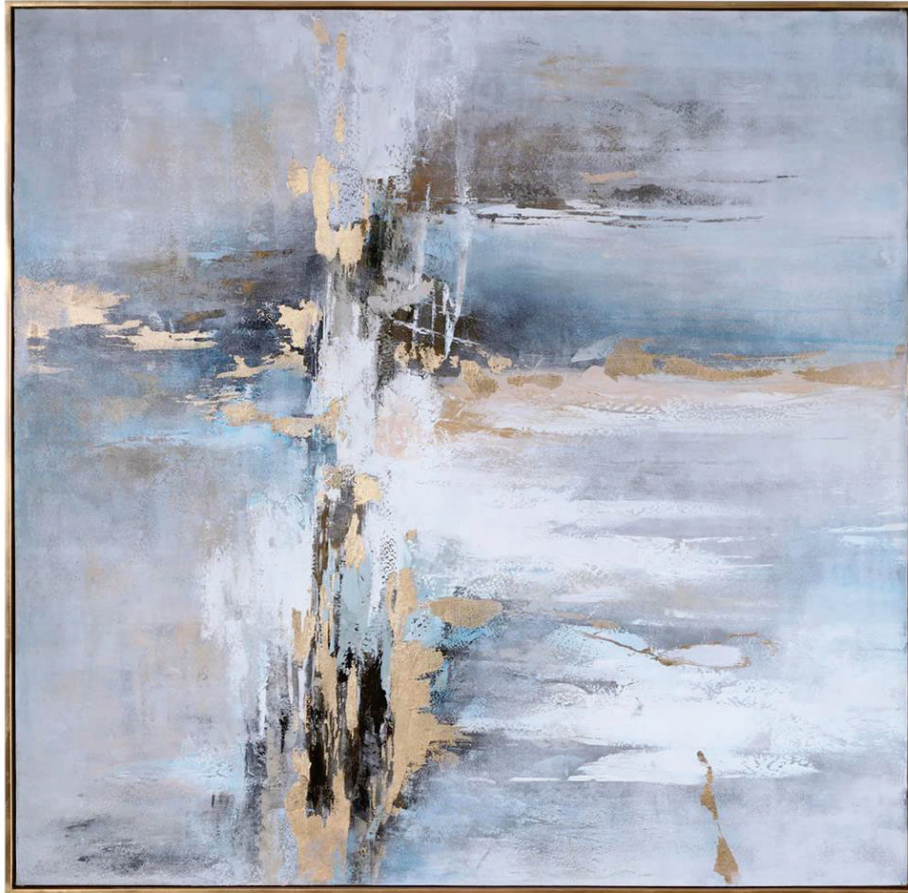

By guarding it according to your word. ¹⁰With my whole heart I seek you; do not let me stray from your commandments. ¹¹I treasure your word in my heart, so that I may not sin against you. ¹²Blessed are you, O Lord; teach me your statutes. ¹³With my lips I declare all the ordinances of your mouth. ¹⁴I delight in the way of your decrees as much as in all riches. ¹⁵I will meditate on your precepts and fix my eyes on your ways. ¹⁶I will delight in your statutes; I will not forget your word. ¹⁷Deal bountifully with your servant, so that I may live and observe your word. ¹⁸Open my eyes, so that I may behold wondrous things out of your law. ¹⁹I live as an alien in the land; do not hide your commandments from me. ²⁰My soul is consumed with longing for your ordinances at all times. ²¹You rebuke the insolent, accursed ones, who wander from your commandments; ²²take away from me their scorn and contempt, for I have kept your decrees. ²³Even though princes sit plotting against me, your servant will meditate on your statutes. ²⁴Your decrees are my delight; they are my counselors. ²⁵My soul clings to the dust; revive me according to your word. ²⁶When I told of my ways, you answered me; teach me your statutes. ²⁷Make me understand the way of your precepts, and I will meditate on your wondrous works. ²⁸My soul melts away for sorrow; strengthen me according to your word. ²⁹Put false ways far from me, and graciously teach me your law. ³⁰I have chosen the way of faithfulness; I set your ordinances before me. ³¹I cling to your decrees, O Lord; let me not be put to shame. ³²I run the way of your commandments, for you enlarge my understanding.
