*Psalm 103* NRSV

<sup>1</sup>Bless the Lord, O my soul, and all that is within me, bless his holy name. <sup>2</sup>Bless the Lord, O my soul, and do not forget all his benefits—<sup>3</sup>who forgives all your iniquity, who heals all your diseases, <sup>4</sup>who redeems your life from the Pit, who crowns you with steadfast love and mercy, <sup>5</sup>who satisfies you with good as long as you live so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's. <sup>6</sup>The Lord works vindication and justice for all who are oppressed. <sup>7</sup>He made known his ways to Moses, his acts to the people of Israel. <sup>8</sup>The Lord is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love. <sup>9</sup>He will not always accuse, nor will he keep his anger forever. <sup>10</sup>He does not deal with us according to our sins, nor repay us according to our iniquities. <sup>11</sup>For as the heavens are high above the earth, so great is his steadfast love toward those who fear him; <sup>12</sup>as far as the east is from the west, so far he removes our transgressions from us. <sup>13</sup>As a father has compassion for his children, so the Lord

has compassion for those who fear him. <sup>14</sup>For he knows how we were made; he remembers that we are dust. <sup>15</sup>As for mortals, their days are like grass; they flourish like a flower of the field; <sup>16</sup>for the wind passes over it, and it is gone, and its place knows it no more. <sup>17</sup>But the steadfast love of the Lord is from everlasting to everlasting on those who fear him, and his righteousness to children's children, <sup>18</sup>to those who keep his covenant and remember to do his commandments. <sup>19</sup>The Lord has established his throne in the heavens, and his kingdom rules over all. <sup>20</sup>Bless the Lord, O you his angels, you mighty ones who do his bidding, obedient to his spoken word. <sup>21</sup>Bless the Lord, all his hosts, his ministers that do his will. <sup>22</sup>Bless the Lord, all his works, in all places of his dominion. Bless the Lord, O my soul.
