Employee Status

Part-time (10-20 hours a week)

Purpose

Plan, coordinate, and lead the weekly Alternative Worship Service (in-person Worship and one Online Worship musical piece).

Qualifications

- Five years of worship leading experience.
- Competent with a musical instrument.
- Able to organize and lead band practice.
- Gifted in music as an expression of faith.
- Strong voice and ability to lead congregation in the worship experience.

Accountability

Accountable to the Head of Staff/Pastor and Personnel Team.

Evaluation

The Head of Staff/Pastor and Personnel Team will conduct an initial performance review after the first 90 days. The Head of Staff/Pastor and the Personnel Committee shall conduct annual performance reviews.

Relationship to Session and other music expressions

The two Worship Elders moderate the monthly Worship Team meeting that the Alternative Service Worship Music Leader attends. Immanuel offers two worship styles – traditional and alternative. Occasionally there may be a single combined service with both music styles. Additionally, the Alternative Service Worship Music Leader and Director of Traditional Music will need to coordinate practice times and special events in the Sanctuary.

Responsibilities

- Work closely with Head of Staff/Pastor in the song selection and themes of the services.
- Lead in weekly in-person Worship and production of Online Worship with recorded videos.
- Research and select music in compliance with copyright laws.
- Recruit musicians for the Worship Band.
- Work within the Alternative Worship Service budget.
- Direct weekly rehearsals with other musicians in the Worship Band.
- Attend monthly Worship Team meetings.
- Assemble the ProPresenter worship music slides for Sunday mornings.
- Secure a replacement as required during absences.
- Coordinate practice times and special events in the Sanctuary with Head of Staff and Director of Traditional Music.

Expectations

- Passionate about Christ and corporate worship.
- Recruit, develop, and lead volunteer and hired musicians.
- Effective interpersonal and public communicator.
- Strong planning and administrative skills.
- In touch with, enjoys, and incorporates multiple styles and genres of music in worship (i.e. rock, country, blues, alternative, traditional hymns etc.).
- The ability to sense and communicate effectively and graciously needed changes to fine-tune the sound of the band.
- Provide spiritual leadership and encouragement for the Worship Band.
- Ability to work with ProPresenter, PowerPoint, and video editing software.
