Pastor Transition Update March 22: This week we finished the process of posting our interim opening with the national Presbytery personnel system, the posting was approved mid-week and is now out and about. We have interviewed and begun talking with a bridge Pastor candidate (serving us for a month or two). We are working on the details to present to Session for a vote. We will look for the Bridge Pastor to begin by mid-April. We have pulpit coverage arranged through April 15th. We'll keep you updated, please keep this process in your prayers.

What is Lent? In 2024, the liturgical season of Lent began on Ash Wednesday (February 14th) and ends on the Saturday before Easter (March 24th). The length of the Lenten season was established in the 4th century as a period of 40 days (not including Sundays). The purpose of Lent is self-reflection, discipline and penitence aimed to prepare Christians for Easter and the Resurrection celebration. Lent is intended to remind us of

the sacrifice and hardship that Jesus endured during his 40 days in the desert prior to the beginning of his public ministry. Historically, churches have encouraged members to grow in faith and spiritual consciousness by sacrificing something during this period. We know how this works: giving up a guilty pleasure like chocolate, TV, gaming, Facebook, etc. However, each of us worshipping in the Immanuel congregation is encouraged to add a spiritual dimension to our lives by giving something, doing something, creating something, or becoming something. This is another way we can celebrate the Lenten season as a faith community. What will your "something" be?
