One: Brothers and sisters, God not only asks us to repent, but also assures us of forgiveness. Therefore, let us confess our sins to the One whose love for us is unfailing.


# PRAYER OF CONFESSION

#### \*AFFIRMATION OF FAITH

#### Brief Statement of Faith

All: We trust in God the Holy Spirit, everywhere the giver and renewer of life.
